THE MARIRI YAWANAWA FESTIVAL

THE MARIRI YAWANAWA IS A GRAND CELEBRATION THAT BRINGS TOGETHER REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE 18 VILLAGES OF THE YAWANAWA PEOPLE.

EACH YEAR, THE FESTIVAL TAKES PLACE IN A DIFFERENT YAWANAWA COMMUNITY, AND IN 2026, WE WILL EXPERIENCE A WEEK OF SINGING, DANCING, CEREMONIES, GAMES, PLAY, HEALING, ART, ARTISTIC EXPRESSION, CULTURAL AND SPIRITUAL MANIFESTATION OF THE PEOPLE OF THE PECCARY, DURING THE FULL MOON BETWEEN AUGUST 26TH AND 31ST IN THE YAWARANI VILLAGE - INDIGENOUS LAND OF THE GREGORIO RIVER, ACRE, BRAZIL.

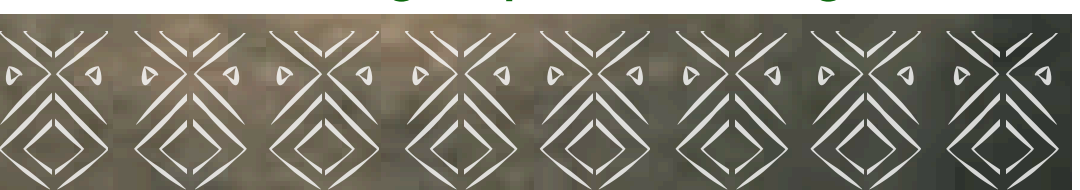


Yawarani Village, Yawanawa Territory, Acre - Amazon, Brazil

SCHEDULE

DURING OUR STAY IN THE COMMUNITY, WE WILL EXPERIENCE DIFFERENT CULTURAL AND SPIRITUAL ELEMENTS OF THE YAWANAWA TRADITION, AND EACH DAY WE WILL HAVE ACTIVITIES INTERSPERSED WITH PERIODS OF REST.

THROUGHOUT THE 6 DAYS AND 7 NIGHTS IN THE HEART OF THE AMAZON RAINFOREST, ALL THE ACTIVITIES LISTED BELOW WILL TAKE PLACE. THE DAY-BY-DAY SCHEDULE WILL BE PRESENTED IN THE VILLAGE, ACCORDING TO GENERAL NEEDS, ESPECIALLY THE ENVIRONMENTAL AND WEATHER CONDITIONS AT THE TIME.

How to get there

We handle external logistics through Rio Branco/Acre or Cruzeiro do Sul/Acre.

The main difference is the travel time; both logistics options are in the PDF.

From Rio Branco/AC, the journey takes 8-10 hours, with an overnight stay in the city of Tarauacá two hours before boarding the river.

And in Cruzeiro do Sul/AC, we spent one night in the city, and the next day, we continued with a direct land trip of about 2-4 hours to the river embarkation point.

The river embarkation takes place in Vila São Vicente/AC, and the boat trip to the Yawãrani Village, within the Yawanawa Territory, in the state of Acre, in the Brazilian Western Amazon, takes approximately 4 hours.

SUGGESTIONS OF WHAT TO BRING

- Pants and long-sleeved shirt (to protect from the sun and mosquitoes)

- Quick-drying open-toe flip-flops or sandals

- Life Straw water filter: in some villages it is necessary to filter or bring water.

Reaching the Yawarāni Village in the Brazilian Amazon requires prior organization and basic external logistics to ensure a safe and comfortable journey.

Starting from your city of origin in Brazil, you must fly to Rio Branco or Cruzeiro do Sul, in the state of Acre, Brazil.

From these cities, we will travel by LAND in chartered cars to São Vicente Village, where our RIVER EMBARKATION takes place: 4-hour motorboat ride to the community, navigating the Gregório River.



The Village Contribution includes **all scheduled activities** in the community, **round-trip river transportation** for the group, plus **accommodation and meals three times a day**: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Village Contribution

- **Children until 8 years old: 4000 BRL**
- **Acre Residents: 6000 BRL**
- **Brazilians: 7000 BRL**
- **Foreigners: 9500 BRL**

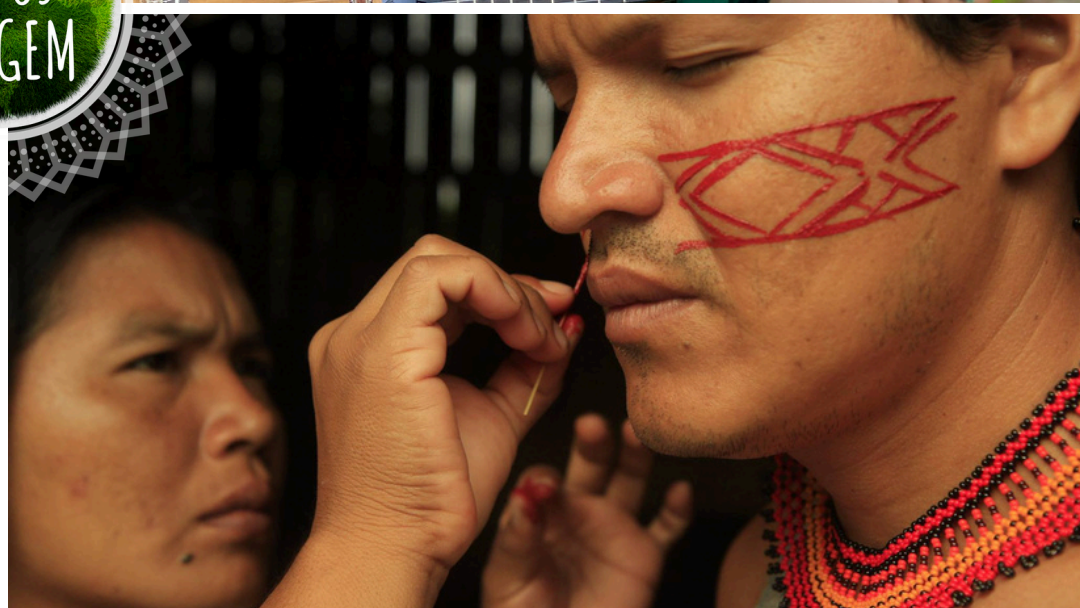


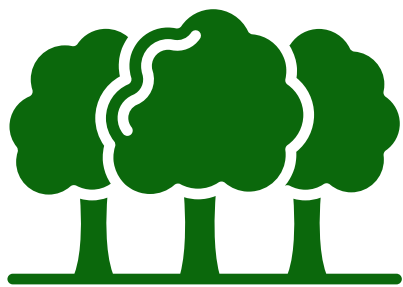
✓ REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MARIRI YAWANAWA FESTIVAL

- PROOF OF PAYMENT OF THE CORRESPONDING VILLAGE CONTRIBUTION.
- DOCUMENTS PROVING RESIDENCY IN THE STATE OF ACRE TO RECEIVE THE ACRE DISCOUNT.
- DOCUMENTS PROVING RESIDENCY IN BRAZIL, FOR FOREIGNERS TO RECEIVE DISCOUNTS AS RESIDENTS OR WITH REFUGEE VISAS.
- THE DISCOUNT FOR COLLABORATORS AND INFLUENCERS WILL BE GRANTED TO PARTICIPANTS APPROVED BY ASCY.
- AFTER PAYMENT CONFIRMATION, REQUEST AND COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION FORM AND LIABILITY WAIVER ONLINE.

Care in the Amazon Environment

We recommend that everyone in the group purchase PRIVATE INSURANCE for traveling to Indigenous Villages in the Amazon.

The event takes place in a natural and wild environment, and the Indigenous Coordination Team informs that during the activities there may be risks of accidents with insects and/or venomous animals, risks of falls of small, medium or large proportions, and that the distance and difficulty of access may hinder immediate assistance, thus exempting the Indigenous Organization and the External Production from any responsibility for any accidents and any burden arising from the provision of medical assistance when necessary.

However, the Indigenous Team and External Production will do everything possible to ensure the visitor's safety, with signage and supervision.

For a safe and enjoyable trip, it is recommended to get the YELLOW FEVER vaccine at least 15 days before arriving in the forest.

Code of Conduct for Visitors within the Community

- Unaccompanied minors are not allowed.
- Alcoholic beverages and other illicit drugs are not permitted.
- Do not enter unauthorized areas.
- Do not photograph or record without permission from the coordinator or the Village Chief.
- For safety reasons, all visitors must wear long pants, a shirt, and sneakers or closed shoes while hiking on the trails.
- Visitors will only be allowed to move around in areas designated as accessible by the Indigenous Team, always accompanied by a member of the Indigenous Team, and may not walk in front of them, leave the trails, or touch leaves or branches.
- Visitors must respect the arrival, stay, and departure times for the available spaces, and the Indigenous Team may change them for administrative reasons or due to force majeure.
